## **BCA to Host Public Meeting in Griffith Over Basin Plan**

The Basin Communities Association – an organisation formed by concerned communities and businesses across the Murray-Darling Basin in the wake of the Basin Plan Guide release – is hosting a public forum in the NSW Riverina town of Griffith this Sunday, 4 December, at the Regional Theatre from 1100.

The Chairman of the BCA, David Michaelis, says the meeting is to receive feedback from businesses and communities across the Basin on the Draft Basin Plan.

“Earlier this year, the BCA conducted an extensive series of forums across the Basin, from Queensland to South Australia, to gain an understanding of what businesses and communities needed from the Basin Plan.

“The forums concluded that businesses and communities in the Basin seek: a rationale for the Plan, balance, detail, local input, broader solutions, transparency and certainty.

“We’re now hosting a public meeting to hear from the community if those criteria have been met by the Draft Basin Plan.
